We've committed \$100 million to improve recycling infrastructure, access and education in communities across the country where we can have the greatest impact. By partnering with The Recycling Partnership and Closed Loop Partners, we're leveraging our investment into \$400 million to support local recycling efforts.

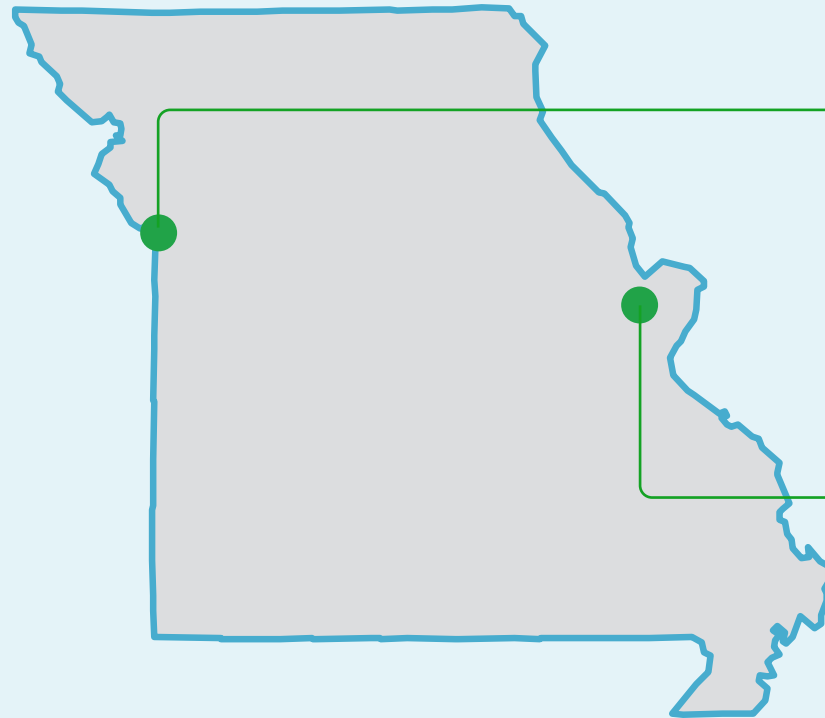

Our \$3 million investment upgraded 161,000 **Kansas City** households from bins to standardized 65-gallon recycling carts. As a result, 165 million lbs. of new recyclables are projected to be collected over the next decade.

An outdated recycling system had **St. Peters** residents bagging their recyclables in blue bags that often ended up in landfills. Our \$320,000 investment provided recycling carts to 20,000 households, modernizing the city's recycling program.
