Syracuse City wanted to provide residents with more access to recycling. We provided 9,850 households in Syracuse City with new recycling carts and education to increase the accessibility of recycling and the likelihood of materials being remade.

Morgan City wanted to support their residents' efforts to recycle. Our investment provided 1,400 new recycling carts and education, increasing recycling rates in the city.

South Weber wanted to boost recycling access. Our \$35,136 investment gave 2,196 households new recycling carts and educational materials.

Morgan County needed to enhance recycling collection in the county. Our investment provided 2,500 recycling carts to households to improve access to recycling services.

Our \$27,680 investment in **Fruit Heights** delivered 1,730 new recycling carts to make it easier for residents to recycle.

Woods Cross aimed to increase recycling. Our \$18,512 investment provided new recycling carts to over 3,000 households.
