Providence needed to reduce recycling contamination and increase access. Our \$2.6M investment helped provide education and free, standardized recycling carts to 55,000 households, increasing the amount of materials being recycled and remade.

Portsmouth wanted to introduce a new recycling approach. Our \$57,200 investment supported educational materials and the distribution of standardized, 95-gallon bins to 4,400 households, streamlining collection and improving recycling efficiency.
